Hello,

This week Senate Bill 1042 was introduced in the California State Senate. The bill would make human trafficking a serious and violent felony (also a strike) in California. Currently, HT is considered a non-serious and non-violent crime under California law. This needs to change. The success of this bill will largely depend on the public's awareness of it. When the HT Proposition that increased the penalties for HT crimes was passed in 2012, it was the most successful Proposition in California history with 81% of the state voting to pass the bill. The public still widely supports anti-trafficking efforts, but most Californians have no idea that HT is defined as a non-serious crime under the Penal Code.

Attached is the official fact sheet about the HT bill. Feel free to share it with anyone that you think would be interested in supporting the effort to change the law. We will be launching a social media campaign on the bill next week and will be doing press conferences across the state to raise awareness in two weeks. If your department would like to participate in the statewide press conference campaign on March 4th, please let me know. We hope to hold several simultaneous press conferences across the state on March 4th to raise awareness of the bill.

If you or any of your HT partners would like to help in the effort to get the word out, please reach out to me. Sharing information about the bill on social media and other platforms would be extremely helpful. We just ask that you and your departments give it about a week before posting on social media since we will be doing an official press release on the bill next week.

In addition to raising awareness, we are looking for any organizations (law enforcement, victim advocates, nonprofits, etc.) that would endorse the bill. When the bill goes to the Public Safety Committee in the Senate, we can provide a list of people/organizations that endorse the bill. The more we get the word out, the more likely California residents will support this bill. As you are likely aware, it is very common to have traffickers with very violent criminal records. Making this bill a strike would have a significant impact on repeat serious/violent offenders.

We observed a spike in our services around the World Series and the NBA all Star game that was in Los Anglels. Happy Monday! Yes that works. I received one report from Mario for **Example**. The only issue I see is that police reports will not always identify the victims as victims of human trafficking. For example, the police report for **Example** does not list the crime code of human trafficking, so if **Example** is interested in also applying for HT Wage Loss through CAL VCB in the future, **Example** would be ineligible based on the police report. If the victim is only interested in accessing therapy services, then the report would suffice.

Thank you for sending this my way. Unfortunately it would be difficult to obtain this information without the specific LAPD or LASD station and the victim's DOB. To obtain a report, I need to contact the specific station and request a report with this information.

Question, does Saving Innocence provide affidavits? I think that Saving Innocence should qualify to provide an HT Caseworker affidavit under CAL VCB policies. This would help avoid the need of obtaining a police report for these and future victims that you refer. I have attached a sample template. Along with the template, I would need the following:

A separate form on a letter head and signed by the caseworker that provides the following:

Victim's name
 Date of the crime
 Crime
 Brief summary of the incident [1-2 short paragraphs at most]
 Injuries and symptoms sustained because of the crime
 County and state that the crime occurred
 Name of the suspect [if known]

With this, I can continue to contact the victims and assist with the CAL VCB applications.

Please let me know if you would be able to provide the affidavit and letters for the victims.
