

***The information below is a WORKING GUIDE to assist DOC officers assigned to do the Situational Awareness Updates on B Watch. This list of sources is not complete and may be edited/updated.**

SPECIAL EVENTS:

Approved/Permitted events by EOD (including planned strikes/demonstrations, parades, marches, cultural events, etc.) Major Sport Events (Staples Center/Dodgers Stadium/ LA Coliseum). Mass crowd outdoor events at Pershing Square, Grand Park, Hollywood Blvd, etc.

WHERE TO FIND:

SPECIAL EVENTS binder in DOC	Copies of approved permits; SALUTE reports from Labor Relations, Media Relations, etc
Noteworthy Special Events Calendars	A hard copy is in the SPECIAL EVENTS binder; its updated weekly by CSS@lapd.lacity.org (Emergency OPS Division); digital copy in RACR inbox; usually sent out on Monday or Tuesday.
RACR Weekly Situation Briefs	Created and updated weekly (mon-sun) by RACR A watch; digital copy in RACR email in box; usually sent out on Mondays
CRD Situational Awareness Report	Created by Community Relations Division; updated daily; digital copy in RACR email inbox.

SITUATIONAL AWARENESS INCIDENTS:

Events/Incident posted on social media and internet websites, pertaining to planned/organized demonstrations; civil activities that may potentially become a UO, incur DOC activation; draw media attention, impact traffic and City functions, incite crowds and become disorderly, etc. Also events promoted by social/political groups/movements who have a significant social media following/influence. Major news incidents related to terrorism, mass shootings, attacks against police, natural and man-made catastrophes with large casualties and property damage (ie. train week, earthquake, major storms, etc).

WHERE TO FIND:

Notifications from internal Department sources	Information acquired and relayed to RACR by personnel from Geo Areas (W/C, CRO), Divisions, Special Units, etc. Original sources must be vetted, otherwise need to confirm with a second source.
Notifications from law enforcement community to RACR Email Inbox	LASD DOC Log, LAFD listmaster, bulletins from FBI, DOJ, JRIC, TLO, etc.
Notifications from news media subscriptions to RACR Email Inbox	NC4.com (protests events); CNN; CBS/NBC etc., via DATAMNR
websites for events	Eventbrite, Facebook events, LA Indymedia.org, LAIST, . Org, IA Center.org, etc. Refer to Excel document: " OPEN SOURCE FOR INTEL-EVENTS " for commonly used sites.
Social Media accounts of known socially active/political groups	Refer to " OPEN SOURCE FOR INTEL-EVENTS " for list of currently monitored groups on Facebook and Twitter.
